CURRENT SITUATION: No significant fire activity was reported yesterday.

Northwest Large Fires:

Two fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy for 27,740 acres.

Northern Rockies Large Fires:

Fifty-six fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy for 57,900 acres.

Eastern Great Basin Large Fires:

Three fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy for 23,840 acres.

Alaska Large Fires:

Eight fires are in a limited protection status totalling 154,568 acres.

OUTLOOK

A cold upper level trough centered over the Rocky Mountains will slowly drift to the east today. The Rocky Mountains will have scattered rain and snow showers. Northern California will have locally breezy north winds. High temperatures will be in the 40's and 50's in the northern and central Rocky Mountains and from the 80's to mid 90's in California and the desert Southwest. Most other areas will have highs in the 60's and 70's.
