CURRENT SITUATION: The Eastern Great Basin Area experienced one new large fire yesterday. Moderate initial attack activity occurred in northern California.

Western Great Basin Large Fires:

RUBY LAKE REFUGE, Humboldt NF. This fire is burning in steep terrain and downed timber north of Ruby Lake National Wildlife Refuge.

Three fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy for 23,840 acres.

Northwest Large Fires:

One fire is in a confine suppression strategy totalling 16,005 acres.

Northern Rockies Large Fires:

Fifty-six fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy totalling 57,900 acres.

Alaska Large Fires:

Six fires are in a limited protection status totalling 84,512 acres.

OUTLOOK:

A cold front will move into the central and southern Rockies while surface high pressure covers most of the Pacific Northwest and Northern Rockies. A surface thermal trough will push northward from California into western Oregon. Strong east winds are forecast for the west slopes of the Cascades and coast range in western Washington and western Oregon. Isolated showers and thunderstorms will develop along the cold front in Colorado, eastern Utah and northern New Mexico. Montana, Idaho and Wyoming should be dry but unseasonably cool. California, southern Nevada and Arizona will be very warm and dry. High temperatures will range from the 50's and 60's in the northern tier of the States to the 80's and 90's in California and just over 100 in the desert southwest.
