

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 1996 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

*** SAFETY COMES FIRST ON EVERY FIRE, EVERY TIME ***

CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity remained minimal in the Western U.S. Florida state reported continued fire activity and South Carolina state reported increased initial attack activity.

Eastern Great Basin Large Fires:

Three fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy for 23,840 acres.

Northwest Large Fires:

One fire is in a confine suppression strategy totalling 16,005 acres.

Northern Rockies Large Fires:

Forty-two fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy totaling 55,026 acres.

OUTLOOK:

A deep upper level trough is beginning to drop southward into the Rockies bringing cooler weather and breezy conditions to Oregon, northern California, northern Nevada, northern Utah, Idaho and Wyoming. Scattered rain and snow showers are forecast for Montana and Wyoming. A slight chance of showers and thunderstorms are possible in Utah. Scattered to widely scattered showers and thunderstorms are forecast in Colorado, Arizona and New Mexico. The remainder of the West will be dry. High temperatures will range from the 40's and 50's in the Northern Rockies to the 60's and 70's in the Pacific Northwest and Great Basin to the 90's in the desert southwest.
