 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Increased initial attack activity was reported in the Southern Area this past week.

OUTLOOK: Louisiana across to South Carolina will be dry through Saturday. Showers and a few thunderstorms will move in the area late Saturday and Sunday. Monday and Tuesday will be dry again with showers and thunderstorms returning late Tuesday through Thursday. High temperatures will be in the mid 60's to near 70 today cooling to the 50's and mid 60's by Sunday. Florida will be dry through Saturday with a chance of showers Sunday through Thursday. High temperatures will be in the lower 70's north to near 80 in the south.
