CURRENT SITUATION: Minimal initial attack activity was reported in the Southern Area this past week.

OUTLOOK: A cold front over Mississippi will move into central Florida Thursday and will be stationary through Sunday. The front will bring rain and thunderstorms, with dry and cool conditions north of the front. Another storm will move into the area Sunday through Tuesday, bringing more showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 50's in Mississippi and Alabama. Florida will have high temperatures in the 60's in the north, to low 80's in the south.
