CURRENT SITUATION: Minor initial attack fire activity continued in the Southern Area. One large fire was reported in Louisiana.

OUTLOOK: A cold front will approach the Southeast Coast States with breezy southwest winds ahead of it Saturday. This will bring a chance of showers and thunderstorms with breezy northeast winds behind the front. The front will stall across south Florida on Sunday. High pressure will build over the area from Sunday through Tuesday, bringing dry and cooler conditions, except across central and south Florida where a chance of showers will continue. A storm system could form off of the southeast coast late Tuesday and Wednesday, returning the chance of showers to the coastal sections. High temperatures will range from the 60's in North Carolina to the mid 80's in south Florida today then cooling to the 40's in North Carolina and upper 70's in south Florida by mid-week.
