

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 FRIDAY, JANUARY 3, 1997 - 1000 MST  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Minor initial attack activity was reported in the Southern and Southwest Areas. No activity was reported for the remainder of the United States.

OUTLOOK: Texas will be dry and unseasonably warm today. A cold front will bring cooler temperatures with scattered showers and thunderstorms in the central and south part of the state over the weekend. Widespread rain with some snow in the west will cover the state Monday through Thursday as a major storm develops over the southern Rockies and the Gulf Coast states. High temperatures will be in the 70's to lower 80's today. Temperatures will drop into the 50's and 60's by Sunday and the 30's and 40's in the north and west by Thursday. Florida will be dry and unseasonably warm today and Saturday. A few showers and thunderstorms are possible in the northwest part of the state Sunday due to a cold front moving into the Carolinas and Georgia. Showers and thunderstorms will increase over the state Tuesday through Thursday as a storm moves in from the southern Rockies into the Gulf Coast states. High temperatures will be in the upper 70's to lower 80's through Sunday then cool into the 70's by Monday or Tuesday.
