OUTLOOK: New Mexico and Arizona will see mostly sunny skies and hot temperatures. A few mountain thunderstorms may develop in northern New Mexico. High temperatures will be in the 80's and 90's except up to 110 in the lowest deserts. In southern Colorado, partly cloudy skies with scattered afternoon and evening thunderstorms will prevail. Highs will be in the 60's and 70's in the mountains and 80's in the valleys. Nevada and Utah will be partly cloudy and breezy with isolated mountain thunderstorms. Highs will be in the 70's and 80's north to 105 in the southern deserts. California will be mostly cloudy and relatively cool. Highs will range from the 60's along the coast and in the mountains to the 90's in the interior deserts. Minnesota will be partly cloudy with a chance of thunderstorms. Highs will be in the 70's and 80's with 5-15 MPH southeast winds.
