

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 4, 1997 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Minimal fire activity was reported throughout the United States. Very high to extreme fire indices continue to be reported in southern California, Arizona, New Mexico, Michigan and Minnesota.

A fixed wing aircraft doing a reconnaissance flight on the San Carlos Agency in Arizona crashed yesterday. The pilot and observer suffered fatal injuries.

OUTLOOK:

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED FOR SOUTHERN NEVADA AND ***
*** NORTHWESTERN ARIZONA FOR STRONG WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITIES. ***

Southern Nevada and Arizona will be windy and partly cloudy with temperatures ranging from the 70's in the mountains to the low 100's in the deserts. Northern Nevada will be cloudy and breezy with high temperatures in the 60's and 70's. New Mexico will be sunny and warm with a few mountain thunderstorms in the northeastern portion of the state. California will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers. High temperatures will range from the 60's along the coast and in the mountains to the 90's in the interior deserts. Utah and southern Colorado will be partly cloudy with afternoon and evening thunderstorms. High temperatures will reach the 60's and 70's in the mountains and the 80's in the valleys.
