

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SATURDAY, JUNE 7, 1997 - 0900 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Minimal fire activity was reported yesterday. Very high fire dangers were reported in southern California, Arizona, New Mexico, and Montana. Arizona also reported numerous units in extreme fire danger.

OUTLOOK: An upper level low pressure system will spread showers and thunderstorms over the Southwest Area, the Great Basin and Colorado. Temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's north and 80's and 90's south. California will be partly cloudy with afternoon showers or thunderstorms over the mountains and southern deserts. High temperatures in the 60's and 70's along the coast and in the mountains. The interior valleys and deserts will range in the 80's and 90's. Southern Alaska will have periods of rain. The central portion of the state will be partly cloudy and very warm with a few afternoon showers and thunderstorms. Temperatures will be in the 60's south and in the 70's to mid 80's in the interior. Minnesota will be mostly sunny with highs in the 70's.
