

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, JUNE 10, 1997 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Alaska continued to experience increased fire activity. Fire activity across the remainder of the United States remained minimal. A NIFC infrared aircraft will be mobilized to Quebec, Canada this morning.

OUTLOOK: An upper level trough of low pressure will reside along the California and Nevada border. This will bring a few afternoon thunderstorms over the central and northern mountains. The remainder of the state will be sunny and warmer. The mountains and coast will have temperatures in the 60's and 70's. Highs will reach the 80's in the interior valleys and the upper 90's in the southern deserts. Arizona will be sunny, warmer, and drier. Temperatures will reach the 70's in the mountains and up to 105 in the southern deserts. Southwest New Mexico will be warmer with temperatures in the 70's in the mountains and the 90's in the south. The northeastern portion of New Mexico will be partly cloudy with a few showers and thunderstorms. Southwest Utah and southern Nevada will be warmer and drier with isolated thunderstorms. High temperatures will range from the 70's to near 100 in southern Nevada. The rest of the Great Basin will see scattered showers and thunderstorms with locally heavy rain. A strong high pressure system will remain over the Great Lakes bringing sunny, warm, and dry conditions. Temperatures will be in the 80's. Alaska will have partly cloudy skies with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's.
