

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 SATURDAY, JUNE 14, 1997 - 0900 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Minor initial attack activity was reported throughout the Geographic Areas. Alaska reported increased acreage on a couple of limited fires. Units in Southern California, Arizona and New Mexico continue to report very high and extreme fire indices. Canada continues to experience large fire activity, however, cooler temperatures are present and forecasted.

OUTLOOK:

\*\*\* FIRE WEATHER WATCH HAS BEEN POSTED FOR STRONG WINDS IN NEW MEXICO \*\*\*

New Mexico will be mostly sunny and windy with a chance of afternoon thunderstorms in the north and west. High temperatures in the mountains will be in the 60's and 70's. The valleys will see temperatures in the 70's and 80's with the deserts in the 90's. Arizona will be windy but cooler with higher humidities. High temperatures will be in the 50's to the low 70's in the mountains and in the 80's to 90's in the southern deserts. California will be mostly sunny and breezy. High temperatures will be in the 60's and lower 70's in the mountains and coast, with 70's and 80's in the valleys. The southern deserts will reach the lower 90's. Minnesota and Wisconsin will have cooler and dry conditions with winds in Minnesota up to 20 MPH. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's. Alaska will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 40's north, 50's and 60's south and west, and lower 70's in the central and east portions of the state.
