

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY JUNE 18, 1997 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: No large fire activity was reported nationally. Initial attack continues to be minimal for most Geographic Areas. The Southwest Area continues to report very high and extreme fire dangers.

OUTLOOK: New Mexico will be sunny, warmer and drier with a few mountain thunderstorms. Arizona will be sunny and hot. Temperatures for the Southwest Area mountains will be in the 70's and 80's, with highs in the mid 100's in the deserts. California will also be sunny and dry. A few thunderstorms are forecast over the Sierra Nevada mountains. High temperatures will range from the 60's and 70's in the mountains, the 80's and 90's in the valleys and up to 110 in the deserts. The Great Lakes states will be partly cloudy. A chance of thunderstorms exists for Wisconsin. Temperatures will range from the 60's to near 80. Alaska will be partly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Temperatures will be slightly warmer, reaching the 50's along the coast and the 60's and 70's in the interior.
