CURRENT SITUATION: Increased initial attack activity occurred in several Areas. Units in California, Nevada, Arizona, New Mexico, Utah and Colorado are reporting very high to extreme fire indices.

Northern California will have northeast winds gusting to 30 MPH. The remainder of the state will have dry conditions. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's along the coast and mountains, the 80's in the valleys, and up to 105 in the deserts. Arizona will be mostly sunny, hot and locally breezy. Mountain temperatures will be in the 70's to highs of 108 in the southern deserts. Dry and warm weather is forecast for New Mexico. A few afternoon thunderstorms are possible for the central mountains and eastern portion of the state. Temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's in the mountains and the 90's to 101 in the valleys and deserts. Alaska has a chance of rain along the southeast coast and in the north, with dry conditions elsewhere. Northern Alaska and the coastal areas will have temperatures in the 50's and 60's. The Alaska interior will have temperatures in the 70's.
