

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 THURSDAY JUNE 26, 1997 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Alaska continued to experience fire activity, with large acreage increases on existing fires. A smokejumper booster crew was ordered for Alaska last night. Very high to extreme fire dangers were reported in southern California, Arizona, New Mexico, Utah, Colorado and Montana.

OUTLOOK: Alaska will be partly cloudy and warm with widely scattered showers or thunderstorms in the south. Temperatures will range from the 60's along the coast to the 70's and 80's inland. Arizona will be mostly sunny, warm and dry with isolated afternoon thunderstorms in the east. Some areas will have locally breezy conditions. Mountain temperatures will be in the 80's, with desert highs up to 110. New Mexico will be partly cloudy with widely scattered thunderstorms in the east and isolated thunderstorms in the west. Temperatures will range from the 70's and 80's in the mountains to the 90's and 100's in the valleys and deserts. California will be mostly sunny and locally breezy. Coastal temperatures will be in the 70's, valley highs will be in the 80's and 90's and desert temperatures will reach 105.
