

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT

NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Minnesota State was busy again yesterday with initial attack activity. Most of the fires were in the Brainerd area in grassy fuels. Southern California has one new large fire. Minor initial attack activity was reported elsewhere.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

SHOOTING, Angles NF. The fire is located near Tujunga which is southeast of San Fernando. The fire laid down last night and containment is expected early this morning.

OUTLOOK: Florida will have partly cloudy skies and temperatures reaching into the 80's. A storm over the Ohio Valley will spread rain from southern Minnesota to lower Michigan. Northern Minnesota and upper Michigan will be partly cloudy. The Great Lake States will have high temperatures in the 40's to mid 50's. Southern California will be sunny, warmer and drier. Arizona and New Mexico will be partly cloudy and less windy. High temperatures will be in the 60's in the mountains, the lower 90's in the southern deserts, and the 80's in the coastal valleys of Southern California. The Fairbanks and Delta areas of Alaska will be partly cloudy with showers or thundershowers in the afternoon. High temperatures will be near 50 degrees.
