

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, MAY 5, 1997 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: No significant fire activity was reported over the weekend. Fire indices are increasing in the Southwest and Southern California Areas with several units reporting high to extreme indices.

OUTLOOK: *** RED FLAG WARNINGS AND FIRE WEATHER WATCHES ARE POSTED FOR PARTS OF NORTHERN FLORIDA THIS AFTERNOON DUE TO LOW HUMIDITIES ****

High pressure is forecast to build over Florida today bringing less wind but continued dry air. Skies will be sunny with high temperatures in the mid to upper 70's in the north and central and in the mid 80's in the south. A strong ridge of high pressure will continue to produce sunny skies over southern California and Arizona. High clouds moving northward from Mexico will spread into New Mexico bringing partly cloudy skies and a slight chance of an afternoon shower or thunderstorm over the mountains and eastern plains. Warmer than normal temperatures will continue over the Southwest and southern California. High temperatures will be in the 90's to 100 in the lower deserts and valleys of southern California and Arizona, 70's and 80's above 3,000 feet and around 70 along the coastal sections.
