

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
WEDNESDAY, MAY 7, 1997 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Large fire activity occurred in Florida. Minor initial attack activity was reported elsewhere. Very high to extreme fire indices continue to be reported in southern California, Arizona, Minnesota and Wisconsin.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

The Gila NF has 2 Prescribed Natural Fires burning for 3,100 acres.

OUTLOOK:

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN NORTHERN FLORIDA FOR LOW HUMIDITIES.***

A dry high pressure system will remain over Florida, bringing sunshine and high temperatures in the 80's. Minimum relative humidities in northern Florida will be near 30%. A ridge of high pressure will linger over southern California, Arizona, and New Mexico. This area will be partly cloudy and very warm, with isolated thunderstorms in northern New Mexico. Arizona will have minimum relative humidities as low as 10%. Temperatures will range from the 70's in the mountains to near 100 in the southwest deserts. Minnesota and Wisconsin will have scattered showers and thunderstorms as a cold front moves into the area. These storms will move into northwestern Michigan by this evening. High temperatures will be in the 50's and 60's.
