

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
SUNDAY, MAY 25, 1997 - 0900 MDT  
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: No significant fire activity was reported. Several units in Southern California and the Southwest are reporting high to extreme fire danger.

OUTLOOK:

\*\*\* ARIZONA FOR GUSTY WINDS, LOW HUMIDITIES AND LOW FUEL MOISTURE \*\*\*

Minnesota will be partly cloudy with east to northeast winds 10 to 20 MPH. Highs 55 to 65. Arizona, New Mexico, Utah and southern Colorado will be partly cloudy with isolated afternoon and evening thunderstorms mainly over the mountains. Highs will range from 60 to 70 in the mountains to the 90's in the southern deserts. California will be partly cloudy with strong winds over the mountains and deserts. Nevada will have highs in the 60's and 70's with 80's and 90's in the southern deserts.
