

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, MAY 26, 1997 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Southern California experienced initial and extended attack fire activity yesterday. No other significant activity was reported. Numerous units in southern California and the Southwest continue to report high to extreme fire danger.

OUTLOOK:

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR STRONG WINDS IN NEW MEXICO ***

Arizona, New Mexico, Utah and southern Colorado will be partly cloudy today. Colorado will have scattered afternoon and evening thunderstorms. New Mexico will be very windy. High temperatures will be in the 70's, except 40's in the northern mountains and 90's in the southern deserts. California and Nevada will be partly cloudy and warmer today. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's in the mountains to the 80's and 90's in the southern deserts. Minnesota will be partly cloudy with east to northeast 10-20 MPH winds. High temperatures will be in the 60's.
