CURRENT SITUATION: No significant fire activity was reported over the holiday weekend. Southern California and Alaska reported increased initial attack activity yesterday.

OUTLOOK: California and Nevada will be mostly sunny today. High temperatures will be in the 70's with 60's in the mountains to near 90 in the deserts. Arizona, New Mexico, Utah and southern Colorado will be partly cloudy with scattered afternoon and evening thunderstorms over Colorado. High temperatures will be mostly in the 60's and 70's with 90's to 100 in the southern deserts.
