

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 1997 - 1000 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Moderate initial attack fire activity was reported in the Southern Area this past week. Minimal fire activity was reported elsewhere. Fire indices in southern California have moderated.

OUTLOOK: Southern California will be dry, except for a slight chance of rain Sunday or Monday. High temperatures through Monday will be in the mid 40's to lower 50's in the mountains, mid 50's to near 70 in the valleys and 70's in the deserts. Temperatures will warm 5-10 degrees through mid-week.

A cold storm system will bring rain from Kentucky to Georgia tonight with a few showers and thunderstorms across Florida. The storm will bring windy conditions through Sunday. High pressure will bring cold and dry weather from Saturday through mid-week. High temperatures will range from 40 in Kentucky to the 70's in Florida.
