

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 1997 - 1000 MST  
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: One large fire was reported in Florida this past week, otherwise minimal fire activity was reported nationally.

OUTLOOK: A cold front with rain and scattered thunderstorms will move eastward from the Ohio and Mississippi valleys today into Georgia and Florida tonight and Saturday. High pressure and dry weather will dominate Sunday through Tuesday. A chance of isolated showers along the southeast coast of Florida exists Sunday. Another cold front will move into Texas and the Mississippi valley Wednesday and Thursday. High temperatures will range from the 50's in Georgia to the 60's and 70's in southern Florida.
