

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
THURSDAY, OCTOBER 2, 1997 - 0530 MDT  
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: The Eastern Great Basin reported one new large fire. Minimal initial attack activity was reported elsewhere. Several units in California continue to report very high fire indices. A few units in the Rocky Mountain and Eastern Great Basin Areas reported very high fire indices.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN LARGE FIRES:

HIGHWAY 55, Boise District, BLM. A Type II Incident Management Team (Raddatz) is assigned. This human caused fire is burning 4 miles northeast of Eagle, Idaho. Rough terrain and spotting are hampering control. Current threats are homes, cabins and historic mining sites.

OUTLOOK:

A RED FLAG WARNING IS POSTED FOR SOUTHEAST OREGON AND SOUTHERN IDAHO THIS MORNING FOR DRY AND WINDY CONDITIONS AHEAD OF A COLD FRONT. A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR SOUTHWESTERN WYOMING AND EASTERN AND SOUTHERN NEVADA FOR DRY AND WINDY CONDITIONS AHEAD OF A COLD FRONT.

Southern Idaho, Nevada and Western Wyoming will have gusty winds associated with the passage of a cold front. It will be dry except for scattered showers from southeastern Oregon to central Idaho and northwestern Wyoming. Temperatures will range from the 50's to 70's except 80's to 100 in southern Nevada.

California will be locally windy and dry. It will be cooler in the north. Temperatures will be in the 70's in the mountains, 70's and 80's in the coastal valleys, and 80's to 100 in the inland valleys and deserts.

Montana will be windy with showers mainly in the west and north. Temperatures will be 50's in the west to the lower 80's in the southeast.
