NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Containment objectives were met on the large fires in Texas.

Minimal fire activity was reported elsewhere. Several units in southern California and one unit in Texas reported very high fire indices.

OUTLOOK:

Southern Idaho and western Wyoming will be partly cloudy, cool and windy with a slight chance of showers. Temperatures will be in the 40's and 50's in the mountains and 50's to 60's in the valleys. Nevada will be partly sunny, breezy and a little cooler with a slight chance of showers along the northern border. Temperatures will range from the 60's and 70's in the north and 80's and 90's in the south.

California will be mostly sunny with a few clouds along the coast. The northern mountains can expect breezy conditions. Temperatures will be in the 60's to near 80 in the mountains, 70's to mid 80's in the coastal valleys, and 80's to 102 in the inland valleys and deserts.

The Southern Plains, western Gulf States, and Texas will be partly cloudy and warm with a chance of showers. Temperatures will be in the 80's. Louisiana will be mostly sunny and warm with highs in the 80's.
