CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity increased in Texas over the weekend. Minimal fire activity was reported elsewhere. A couple of units in southern California and one unit in Texas reported very high fire indices.

OUTLOOK:

Texas will have scattered showers and thunderstorms. Louisiana will be partly cloudy and warm with a few showers and thunderstorms in the southwest. High temperatures will be in the 80's.

Southern Idaho and western Wyoming will be windy with increasing clouds and a chance of late afternoon showers. Southwest Wyoming will have southwest winds, gusting to 40 mph. High temperatures will be in the 50's in the mountains and 60's to lower 70's in the valleys. Nevada will be cooler, partly cloudy and breezy with a slight chance of showers along the northern border. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's in the north to the 80's and 90's in the south.

California is forecast to have gusty north winds, up to 30 mph in the northern Sacramento valley. Clouds and a few showers are possible in the far north, otherwise it will be mostly sunny and warm. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's along the coast and in the mountains, to the 80's and 90's in the inland valleys and deserts.
