

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 8, 1997 - 0530 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Minimal fire activity was reported throughout the United States. Two units in southern California reported very high fire indices.

OUTLOOK:

Southern and central California will be windy, dry and cool. Northern California will have increasing clouds with valley rain. A winter storm watch has been issued for the far northern mountains. The snow level will be at the 6,000 and 7,000 foot elevations. Temperatures will range from the 40's in the northern mountains to the 80's in the southern inland valleys.

Texas and Louisiana will have rain and thunderstorms. Temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's throughout the area.
