

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 14, 1997 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Minimal initial attack activity was reported in California. Five units in southern California reported very high to extreme fire indices.

OUTLOOK:

A RED FLAG WARNING IS POSTED THIS MORNING IN AREAS WITHIN AND BELOW THE LARGER CANYONS AND PASSES OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA FOR SANTA ANA WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITIES.

California will be dry with breezy northeast winds across the central and southern parts of the state. Temperatures will be well above normal, ranging from the high 60's to mid 70's in the mountains, and from the 80's to mid 90's in the inland valleys and southern deserts.

A cold front will push into southern Mississippi and northern Florida. Ahead of the front there will be a chance of showers and thunderstorms with highs in the 80's. Behind the front it will be dry and cooler with gusty northwest winds. Temperatures will range from near 60 in Kentucky to the mid 70's along the gulf coast.
