NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Initial attack activity increased in northern California and the Southern Area. Several units in southern California reported very high to extreme fire indices.

OUTLOOK:

California will be hot, dry and less windy. There will be locally northeast winds 15-25 mph in the southern part of the state. Temperatures will be in the mid 60's to near 80 in the mountains, and 80's and 90's in the coastal valleys to the deserts.

Louisiana, Mississippi and Kentucky will be dry with a chance of showers and thunderstorms in north Florida. There will be breezy north winds 10-20 mph. Temperatures will be near 60 in Kentucky to the 70's in north Florida.
