

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17, 1997 - 0530 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Minor initial attack activity occurred in the Southwest and New York. Several units in southern California to report very high to extreme fire indices.

OUTLOOK:

California will experience a cooling trend today. Locally breezy east winds of 10 to 20 mph should continue for southern California. Highs will range from the upper 60s to the mid 80s in the mountains with mid 80s to mid 90s in the coastal valleys and deserts.

Louisiana, Mississippi and Kentucky will be dry with a chance of showers and thunderstorms in north Florida. There will be breezy north winds 10-15 mph. Temperatures will be near 60 in Kentucky to the 70's in north Florida.
