NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Large fire activity was reported in Southern California. Minimal initial attack activity occurred elsewhere. Several units in southern California continue to report very high to extreme fire indices.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

BAKER, Orange County, California State. This fire is located 2 miles east of Tustin, CA. A spot fire jumped containment lines yesterday and burned an additional 500 acres.
