NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Minor initial attack activity was reported in the Southern California Area. Several units in southern California continue to report very high to extreme fire indices.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

BAKER, Orange County, California State. This fire is located 2 miles east of Tustin, CA. Firefighters made good progress on line construction. The decrease in size is due to more accurate mapping.
