CURRENT SITUATION: Increased fire activity was reported by several Areas. Four units in southern California reported very high to extreme fire indices. One unit in Wyoming reported very high fire danger.

OUTLOOK:

An upper level low pressure system will be over southern California, bringing partly cloudy to cloudy skies with a chance of showers. There will be extensive fog and low clouds along the coast and coastal valleys. Northern California will be mostly sunny. Temperatures will be in the 60's in the mountains and 70's and 80's in the valleys and deserts.

A cold front will extend from the Carolinas into Louisiana. Mississippi and Louisiana will be mostly cloudy with areas of rain. Kentucky will be partly cloudy with a chance of showers in the south. Northern Florida will be mostly sunny and mild. Temperatures will range from the 50's in Kentucky to the 70's elsewhere.
