NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity continued in the Southern Area. Minimal fire activity was reported elsewhere. Four units in southern California continued to report very high fire indices. One unit in Texas reported very high fire danger.
