

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SATURDAY, OCTOBER 25, 1997 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: The Southern Area continued to experience moderate initial attack activity. Northern California experienced some minor initial attack and large fire activity. Minimal initial attack activity was reported elsewhere. Several units in California are reporting very high to extreme indicies.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

HONEYMOON, Shasta-Trinity Ranger Unit, California State. This fire is burning 25 miles northwest of Redding, CA. The fire is burning in steep, inaccessible terrain. The current threat is to watershed areas which feed the community of French Gulch and Whiskytown National Park. High winds have hampered control efforts. Containment is expected later today.

A RED FLAG WARNING IS POSTED FOR STRONG NORTH TO NORTHEAST WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITY FOR NORTHERN CALIFORNIA.

California will be sunny and mild with strong north to northeast winds as high pressure builds into the Great Basin. Winds of 20 to 35 mph will be common with higher gusts in the wind prone areas, especially below the canyons and passes. Temperatures will be in the 50's to mid 60's in the mountains and 70's to lower 80's in the valleys and deserts.

Louisiana, Mississippi and Kentucky will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Northern Florida will be partly cloudy with only a few afternoon showers or thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 60's in Kentucky to the lower 80's along the Gulf Coast.

Indiana to Maine will be mostly cloudy with showers. High temperatures will be in the mid 40's north to near 60 south.
