

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 FRIDAY, OCTOBER 31, 1997 - 1000 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: The Angeles NF in southern California had a 75 acre fire and Boise District BLM in Idaho had a 120 acre fire this past week. Minimal initial attack fire activity was reported nationally for the week. Several units in southern California are reporting very high to extreme fire indices.

OUTLOOK: High pressure over northern California will bring dry and breezy northwest to northeast winds to southern California today. The high will push into the Great Basin Saturday and Sunday bringing hot and gusty Santa Ana winds. Southern California will be dry with less wind and cooler through the rest of next week. High temperatures will be in the upper 60's and 70's in the mountains. The valleys and deserts will be in the mid 80's to mid 90's through the weekend then cooling to the upper 70's to near 90 for the remainder of the week.

Two cold fronts will push across Florida through Sunday, bringing showers and thunderstorms, with breezy conditions through Monday. Monday and Tuesday will be drier and cooler. Another storm system may bring showers and thunderstorms by Thursday. High temperatures will be in the 70's in the northern part of the state to the upper 80's in the south today. High temperatures will be cooler Monday and Tuesday then warming up on Wednesday and Thursday.
