

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 5, 1997 - 0530 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Large fire activity occurred in Southern California. Minimal fire activity was reported elsewhere. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported on several units in the California, Western Great Basin and Northern Rockies Areas.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

MARGARITA, San Diego Ranger Unit, California Department of Forestry. This fire is threatening scattered homes in Deluz Canyon, 2 miles southwest of Temecula, CA.

The fire is actively burning in heavy brush. Heavy smoke is hampering airtanker activity.

OUTLOOK:

California will be partly sunny and very warm. A slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms exists in the southern mountains and deserts. High temperatures will range from the 70's and 80's in the mountains, the 90's in the valleys, to 105 in the deserts.

Nevada will be mostly sunny with isolated thunderstorms in the east and south. High temperatures in the north will range from 80 to near 90 while the south will be in the 90's to 103.

Utah will be partly cloudy with a chance of showers and thunderstorms over the mountains. High temperatures will be in the 80's to mid 90's.

Idaho will be partly cloudy with a chance of afternoon and evening showers and thunderstorms, especially in the north. High temperatures will be in the 70's to lower 80's in the mountains and 80's to lower 90's in the valleys.

Montana will be partly cloudy and warm with a few late afternoon and

evening thunderstorms. Highs temperatures will be in the 80's.
