CURRENT SITUATION: No significant fire activity was reported nationally. Very high fire indices continue to be reported on several units in the Southern California, Western Great Basin and Northern Rockies Areas.

OUTLOOK:

California will be partly cloudy with a chance of showers and thunderstorms in the southern mountains and deserts. Northern California will be breezy. High temperatures will be in the mid 60's and 70's along the coast, 70's in the mountains, and 90's to 102 in the inland valleys and deserts.

Nevada will be partly sunny dry and locally breezy. High temperatures will be in the high 70's to lower 80's in the north and 80's to near 100 in the south.

Utah will be mostly sunny and breezy with a slight chance afternoon showers and thunderstorms in the southeast. High temperatures will range from 75 to 80 in the north and 80 to 90 in the south.
