

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 1997 - 0530 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Moderate initial attack activity was reported in California, the remainder of the country reported minimal fire activity yesterday. Several units in California continue to report very high and extreme fire indices.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

WILLIAMS, Nevada-Yuba-Placer Ranger Unit, California Department of Forestry. A State Type I Incident Management Team (Finnie) is assigned. This fire is located near the community of Dobbins, CA. The damage assessment team released their findings yesterday morning; 83 dwellings, 65 outbuildings, 16 vehicles and 2 commercial structures were destroyed by this fire.
