

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SUNDAY, AUGUST 9, 1998 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Moderate initial attack activity was reported from all Areas. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for a caterer, shower, crews, helicopters, equipment and miscellaneous overhead. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, Nevada, Utah, Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, Washington, Oregon and California.

NORTHWEST LARGE FIRES:

NORTH 25, Wenatchee NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Furlong) is assigned. This fire is located 35 miles northwest of Chelan. A large scale burn out operation has been successful. Structure protection continues.

SKULL CREEK, Burns District BLM. A Type II Incident Management Team (Solarz) has been ordered. This fire is burning actively in light fuels and inaccessible terrain northwest of Fields. The fire crossed State Highway 205 with a flame front that was estimated at two miles wide.

NORTHERN ROCKIES LARGE FIRE:

COPPER CREEK, Helena NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Bullis/Suenram) is assigned. This fire is approximately 45 miles northwest of Helena. Bull Trout spawning habitat and recreational facilities remain threatened. Heavy downed fuels are slowing line construction. Steep slopes and a high number of snags continue to pose control and safety problems.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN LARGE FIRE:

CRANE CREEK CANYON, Boise District BLM. This fire is located 14 miles northeast of Weiser. The fire doubled in size yesterday due to active burning at night and brief periods of shifting winds in steep canyons.

GOOSEBERRY COMPLEX, Boise NF. This fire is located 45 miles northeast of Boise. This complex consists of 20 fires and is being managed by a local Type III Incident Management Team. Flare-ups and torching were observed on several of the fires.

SOUTHWEST LARGE FIRES:

NORTH RIM COMPLEX, Grand Canyon NP. A Type II Incident Management Team (Kleindienst) is assigned. This fire is located 80 miles northwest of Flagstaff. Mop-up and rehabilitation are continuing on the Transept fire. Control lines are holding on the Swamp Lake fire. Some demobilization has begun.

OUTLOOK:

Washington, Oregon, California and western Nevada will be mostly sunny. Eastern Nevada and Wyoming will have partly cloudy skies. Utah, Colorado, Arizona and New Mexico will experience isolated to scattered locally wet afternoon thunderstorms, mainly in the mountains and plateaus. High

temperatures will be in the upper 60's to 70's in the mountains and 80's to 105 in the valleys and deserts.

Texas and Oklahoma will be mostly sunny with continued hot conditions in the west and central areas. The eastern portion will be partly cloudy with isolated to widely scattered wet afternoon thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 90's to 105 and mid 80's in the west Texas mountains.

Arkansas will be partly cloudy with scattered mainly wet afternoon thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the upper 80's to mid 90's.
