

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
TUESDAY, AUGUST 18, 1998 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Moderate initial attack fire activity was reported nationally. Good progress was made on several large fires with containment objectives being achieved. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for aircraft, crews and miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme indices were reported in Texas, Wyoming, Arizona, Montana, Nevada, Utah, Idaho, Oregon and California.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN LARGE FIRES:

NORTH FORK COMPLEX, Salmon-Challis NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Richer) is assigned. The fires are approximately twenty miles west of Salmon. This complex is made up of the Bear Basin and Sheepeater Fires. Fires were not staffed today due to extreme fire behavior. Large scale indirect attack and burnout operations are planned for the Bear Basin Fire.

LOOPSEM CREEK, Boise NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Monahan) is assigned. This fire is located two miles south of Yellow Pine. Crews made significant progress on line construction on the lower perimeter. Occasional torching was the extent of activity reported yesterday.

MAIN SALMON COMPLEX, Salmon-Challis NF. An Interagency Fire Use Management Team (O'Brien) is assigned. This complex is located 40 miles west northwest of Salmon. The complex consists of eleven fires burning in the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness on the Salmon-Challis, Payette, Nez Perce and Bitterroot National Forests. Extended cloud cover combined with scattered light rain, higher humidities and lower temperatures reduced fire activity throughout the complex.

JACKASS, Salmon-Challis NF. This fire is 30 miles southwest of Salmon. No new information was received.

of indirect line is being secured by burnout operations and helicopter bucket work. Demobilization is in progress.

NORTH 25, Wenatchee NF. This fire is located 27 miles northwest of Chelan. Demobilization is in progress.
