

## INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT

SATURDAY, JULY 25, 1998 - 0900 MDT

NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL III

### CURRENT SITUATION:

Fire activity across the nation was moderate. Initial attack efforts were successful and no new large fires were reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for overhead, aircraft and engines. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in Georgia, Texas, Oklahoma, New Mexico, South Dakota, California and Washington.

### SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

BARREL CREEK, Texas State, Briscoe County. This fire is burning in light flashy fuels 50 miles southwest of Amarillo. Containment was expected last night.

#### OUTLOOK:

Scattered wet thunderstorms will form in western New Mexico, Arizona, interior northern California, Nevada, eastern Oregon, Utah, Colorado, and southern Wyoming. Isolated dry scattered thunderstorms are predicted in the interior southern California. Afternoon temperatures will continue to be hot with highs ranging from 80 in the mountains to 115 in the valleys and deserts.

Texas will be breezy across the north grasslands with continued hot and dry conditions for the remainder of the state. West and north Texas will have scattered thunderstorms with dry lightning. The gulf coast will have scattered wet thunderstorms. Temperatures will range from 96 to 106 for most of the state. Coastal temperatures will be 85 to 95.

Arkansas will be mostly cloudy with wet thunderstorms in the north. Scattered wet thunderstorms and partly cloudy skies are forecast in the south. High temperatures will range from mid 85 to near 100.

Oklahoma will be partly cloudy with a slight chance of thunderstorms in the south. A chance thunderstorms are forecast for the northeast portion of the state. Temperatures will range from 80 to 105.
