 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Three type I and two type II crews are being mobilized to Edmonton, Alberta Canada today to assist with wildfires. Very high and extreme fire indices continue to be reported in Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan, Texas and New Mexico.

OUTLOOK: Northwest and central Minnesota will have a chance of showers and thunderstorms today. Southeast Minnesota and Wisconsin will be mostly sunny, but cooler near Lake Michigan. Michigan will be partly to mostly sunny, except the southern part of the state which will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's in Wisconsin and Michigan and in the 70's to near 80 in Minnesota.

Florida will be partly cloudy today with scattered afternoon thunderstorms in the north and central part of the state. Southern Florida will be partly cloudy. High temperatures will be in the 80's.

New Mexico and west Texas will be mostly sunny, warm and breezy. High temperatures will range from the 60's to 80's in the mountains and northwest New Mexico. East and south New Mexico and west Texas will be in the 80's and 90's up to 102 along the Rio Grande.
