

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 1998 - 1000 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fire activity continued in the Southern Area. The Mark Twain NF in the Eastern Area reported increased arson fires. The National Interagency Coordination Center continued to process miscellaneous overhead orders for the Southern Area. High fire danger was reported in Virginia, Missouri and Maryland.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

STONEY LICK, George Washington & Jefferson NF's. A Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) is assigned. The fire is 35 miles southwest of Harrisonburg, near the town of Deerfield. Moisture and gusty winds curtailed burnout operations yesterday. Helicopter bucket drops were utilized to keep the fire from bumping the line.
