

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT

NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Moderate initial attack activity was reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for miscellaneous overhead. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in California.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

EDNA COMPLEX, Riverside Ranger Unit, California Department of Forestry. This complex consists of the Edna and Taylor fires. The Edna fire is located near Banning and the Taylor fire is located between Beaumont and Calimesa. A large backfiring operation performed yesterday was successful.

CAMINO SAN BERNARDO, San Diego Ranger Unit, California Department of Forestry. Six homes and three vehicles have been destroyed. No other information was received.
