

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT

NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity was reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for miscellaneous overhead. Very high fire indices were reported in California and Oregon.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

EDNA COMPLEX, Riverside Ranger Unit, California Department of Forestry. This complex consists of the Edna and Taylor fires. The Edna fire is located near Banning. The Taylor fire is located between Beaumont and Calimesa. Highway 60 is now open after a successful backfiring operation.

A Pacific cold front will bring showers to the Pacific Northwest and Northern Rockies. The remainder of the West will be mostly sunny and warm.
