CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fire activity occurred on Texas State lands. Very little initial attack fire activity was reported as most units are either reporting weekly or closed on weekends.

SOUTHERN AREA INCIDENTS:

HURRICANE GEORGES: Hutchinson's Type I Incident Management Team has been released from the FEMA Receiving and Distribution Center at Roosevelt Roads Naval Base in Puerto Rico. The Team is in surplus status awaiting a reassignment or release to their home unit.

OUTLOOK:

The western United States will have high pressure over much of the area resulting in warmer and drier weather. A cold front will bring rain to most of western Washington, western Oregon and northwest California. The Great Basin and central California will have locally gusty southwest winds. High temperatures will range from the 60's in the north to the 70's and 80's in the south and up to the 90's in the southwest deserts.

West Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be mostly sunny, warm and dry. High temperatures will range from the mid 70's to mid 80's.
