

MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 FRIDAY, OCTOBER 16, 1998 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fire activity increased in the Southwest Area. The National Interagency Coordination center processed orders for three airtankers, 6 type I crews, 3 type III helicopters and a radio system for the Southwest Area. High to very high fire indices were reported in Oregon, California, Montana, Colorado, Kansas, Nevada and South Carolina.

OUTLOOK:

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN ARIZONA AND NEW MEXICO FOR GUSTY WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITY. The West will have 15-30 MPH northwest to northeast winds with gusts to 40 MPH. Eastern Idaho, southern Montana, Wyoming, Utah and western Colorado will have heavy snow in the higher elevations and rain in the lower elevations. The remainder of the West will be dry. High temperatures will range from the 30's in the northern Rockies to the 80's in the southwest deserts.

West Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be mostly cloudy with scattered thunderstorms and 20-30 MPH southwest winds. High temperatures will be in the 70's to mid 80's.
