

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SUNDAY, OCTOBER 18, 1998 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fire activity continued in Southern California and in the Southwest Area. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for airtankers, helicopters, a radio system, shower and miscellaneous overhead. High fire indices were reported in California.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

OGILVY, LOS PADRES NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (McClain) is assigned. This fire is 13 miles northeast of Santa Barbara in the Dick Smith Wilderness. The Red Legged Frog and Arroyo Toad habitat are currently threatened. Heavy fuels, very active fire behavior, steep rocky terrain and the remote location are causing safety problems.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

BS, Gila NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Bateman) is assigned. This fire is 18 miles south of Reserve. Cooler temperatures and less wind allowed crews and dozers to make significant progress on line construction. Acreage increase is due to more accurate mapping.

RAEL, Gila NF. This fire is 12 miles south of Aragon. Demobilization has begun.

OUTLOOK:

A weak frontal system will bring clouds and a few snow or rain showers to eastern Montana and northern Wyoming. High pressure will cover the remainder of the West resulting in mostly sunny skies and a little warmer temperatures. Relative humidity will remain very low in the coastal mountains of southern California and there will be less wind. The

offshore flow will increase in western Washington and western Oregon with gusty northeast to east winds developing tonight. High temperatures will range from the 40's in the northern states to the 70's and 80's in the south.

Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be sunny and cool with highs between 65 and 70.
