A low pressure system over Arizona will bring mostly cloudy, cool and breezy conditions to northern and eastern Arizona with scattered showers. Southern Arizona will be partly cloudy and cooler with a slight chance of showers. Arizona will have 15 to 25 MPH southwest winds. Southern

California will be partly sunny, cooler and breezy with isolated showers or thunderstorms over the eastern deserts. Southern California will have 10 to 20 MPH west to north winds. High temperatures will range from 40's to the 50's in the mountains, 70's along the southern California coast and upper 70's to mid 80's in the deserts.
